Master Black Belt (MBB) candidates are already certified Black Belts who are skilled in change leadership and problem-solving techniques. To reach the next level, we focus on the advanced tools and facilitation skills needed to lead change within your organization.

The differentiating aspects of this program are its discipline, personalized attention, flexibility in learning modes (classroom with online support) and self-paced schedule so you can set timelines and deadlines that work for you.

Candidates begin by getting paired with a Lean Methods Group Master Black Belt program manager who coaches you through every step of the process—selecting electives, passing exams, completing projects, and meeting other certification requirements. With eight electives to choose from for the four required courses, you can choose courses that specifically focus on your needs, whether advanced tool knowledge, innovation techniques, or people and leadership skills. Certification Requirements

- Complete four advanced training courses from a choice of eight electives.
- Achieve a 90% or higher exam grade on Lean Methods Group's Black Belt exams.
- Complete three projects, each showing statistical evidence of a primary metric improvement and one of which should be a large-scale project. Each project report will be assessed against Lean Methods Group's Final Report Deliverables. Coaching can be used in lieu of the large-scale project.
- Deliver a presentation to an appropriate audience. A paper submitted to a periodical can be used in lieu of the presentation.
- Be nominated for MBB status by a 360-degree team. Three letters of nomination are required: one from a supervisor, one from a peer and one from a protégé.
